

COVID-19 Safe Visit Guide for UNVACCINATED Visitors

This information is provided to assist you in making the right decisions for your loved one and other residents whilst visiting our home.

Unvaccinated = No evidence of COVID-19 vaccination OR evidence of 1 dose of COVID-19 vaccination

Before entering the home



Do not proceed if you:

- have symptoms of COVID-19
- have had a COVID-19 test because you have symptoms or have attended an exposure site and are waiting for the result
- are required to isolate or quarantine
- have had contact with a COVID positive person in the past 14 days.
- ✓ Complete the COVID Screening Procedures before entering the home. This includes declaring your vaccination status (see above).
- ✓ Please sanitise your hands and put on the mask and shield supplied to you to wear
- ✓ Sign in to the Allity Access tablet and answer NO to your vaccination status
- ✓ Check in on the Services Victoria QR Code provided also

Once you enter the home

Move to the designated outside area of the Home for your visit. If the weather means you cannot visit outside, your visit must occur in your resident's room only.



Do not remain in common areas of the home

- ✓ Follow safety measures:
 - Hand hygiene
 - Wear masks properly
 - Physical distance of 1.5m at all times
 - Follow signage on density requirements for all spaces

NOTE – If you or anyone you live with or have been in contact with, are confirmed as a positive case or a primary close contact please inform the General Manager as soon as possible.
